This includes items such as computers, tablets, servers, monitor/display screens, scanners, copiers, network equipment, power supplies, TVs, stereos, cell phones and household appliances.

Today the eWorks program provides electronics recycling and refurbishment services for local communities and for large global corporations across the US. eWorks also serves as the back office-processing center for several other national recyclers. Our process uses the highest industry standards in safety and security, as well as, provides "green tech" jobs for the disabled.

RESPONSIBLE RECYCLING


For products that have exceeded their useful life, eWorks has teams of individuals with developmental disabilities dismantling their components into separate material streams for environmentally safe and responsible recycling.

eWorks processes adhere to the strictest standards in the industry and meet all local, state and federal regulations. We are R2 and ISO Certified and only utilize downstream partners that are certified as well. At the same time, providing jobs to those less fortunate from affiliated organizations such as Misericordia and the AHRC.

INFORMATION CONTROLS AND REPORTING

eWorks maintains clear identification and control of items throughout from collection through processing and final disposition whether resale or recycling via its sophisticated data management system.

Reports are available indicating the amount of items and/or poundage of material received along with final disposition. These reports offer the necessary audit trail required to properly manage end of use items and accounting. Each customer can select the level of detail they require for their particular reporting needs.
